Migration to the senior schedule will be dependent on the age, size, skill level and maturity of the student. It will be decided on an individual basis in consultation with their instructor and parents.

6. Ippon and sanbon kumite will be based on the schedules kata content

Progress Awards:

A progress award can be made at the discretion of the class instructor. They are designed to be used in order to ensure the student has a feeling of progression between actual belt gradings in order to keep them motivated. They can also be used to reward exceptional effort.
